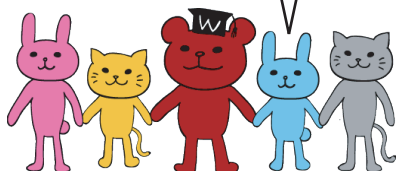
▼What is the Waseda no Mori?

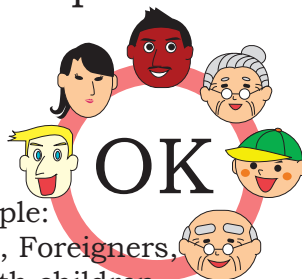

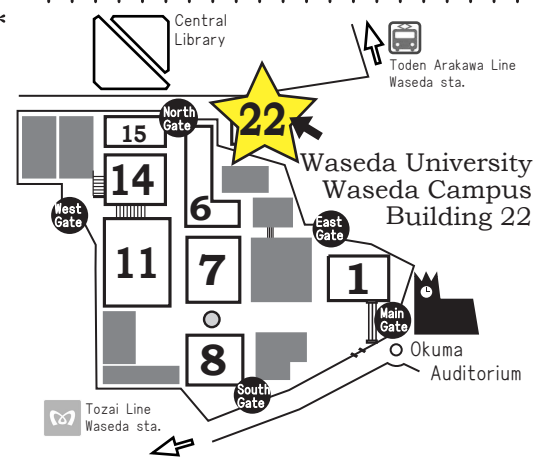
